Safety Code

Policy statement

In the event of an emergency, you will hear the very loud two-tone siren. If this happens, please take note of the following actions:

- Go into the building immediately.
- Close all external doors and windows.
- Pull curtains across windows that face the terminal.
- Turn off any ventilation system that draws air from outside.
- Stay in the room furthest away from the terminal.
- Telephone lines must be kept clear for priority calls, so do not use the telephone until the all clear single-tone siren sounds.
- Tune the radio on to BBC Radio Solent 96.1 fm for public announcements.
- Remain indoors until you hear the 'all clear' siren (which is a slowly reducing single-tone), or instructions are received from emergency services.
- Co-operate fully with all instructions given by emergency services.
- Hamble Village Playschool will follow the above instructions and contact parents and carers by telephone after the all clear.
